HOW TO ENTER

Draw a picture using colour (and label ingredients where possible) of ONE of the following:

1. Loaded hotdog using Naked Pork Sausage.
2. Loaded burger using Finnebrogue Wagyu Burger.
3. Ham sandwich using Finnebrogue Naked Deli Ham.

Your drawing should illustrate a **healthy balanced meal** and alongside the protein above, must include a carbohydrate eg wholemeal or sourdough bread AND some fruit or vegetables, eg. lettuce, spring onions, cherry tomatoes, sweetcorn or red peppers.

Each drawing should include the child's full name and their class, eg. Jane Smith, P2.

Competition Rules

1. Open to primary schools based in Ireland only.
2. Entries from a single class is considered as one entry for the school. Only one entry per school.
3. The completed entry form must accompany submitted entries – post or hand deliver to: Sports Day Competition, Finnebrogue, 46 Belfast Road, Downpatrick, County Down, BT30 9UP; or scan / email your entries to: hello@finnebrogue.com.
4. Deadline for receipt of entries is 16:00 on 10th May 2025. Entries received after this date will not be considered by the judges.
5. The school sports day must take place between 19th May – 6th June.
6. No exchange or cash alternative is available.
7. The winning school will be notified by 14th May 2025 via email to arrange the visit.
8. Winning class (or representatives from the class) will participate in a PR photo at the sports day. School is responsible for obtaining parent permission for the photo.
9. Winning school will receive a visit from the Finnebrogue Food Truck on a mutually agreed date between 19th May – 6th June. The truck will provide hotdogs to all children participating in the sports day. This will include a bread roll and a Finnebrogue Naked Pork Sausage. Dietary requirements will be catered for if supplied to Finnebrogue one week in advance of the arrival date. All sausages are produced in a gluten-free facility.
10. Judging: Finnebrogue will three winning entries based on their innovative ideas and creativity and keeping within the theme boundaries of a healthy balanced diet that includes one of the following proteins: Finnebrogue Naked Pork Sausage, Finnebrogue Wagyu Burger, Finnebrogue Naked Deli Ham.
